



Pupil Premium Allocation 2012 – 13

Pupil Premium is money that has been allocated to support pupils from low income families, who are currently eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) or have been eligible at any point during the last six years (known as the Ever 6 FSM Measure). Below is the key information relating to the allocation and spending of this money during the 2012-13 academic year.

Number of students benefitting: 6

Total allocation received: £3726

How the money is spent:

Activity	Total spend
Specific learning/reading resources	£1,449
Extra Curricular opportunities	£1035
1-1 learning/reading support	£1242

Impact: As a result of this focus on reading 83% of these pupils are on track or above to make their 12 points progress and 66% of them are ahead of the target.
