



Pupil Premium Allocation

[2013 - 2014]

Pupil Premium is money that has been allocated to support pupils from low income families, who are currently eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) or have been eligible at any point during the last six years (known as the Ever 6 FSM Measure). Below is the key information relating to the allocation and spending of this money during the 2013-14 academic year.

Number of students benefitting: 16

Total allocation received: £5,612

How the money is spent:

Our pupil premium allocation was spent on funding 1-1 tuition of eligible students in reading, writing and maths. Pupils were taken out of the class at various times during the week, to be supported in their basic skills by a qualified teacher.

Impact of spending

The average number of points progress made was as follows

Reading	Writing	Maths
5.6	4.9	8.0

(In order to contextualise these data it is worth noting 75% of these pupils are in KS2, where the Dfe's progress expectation is 3 points)
